

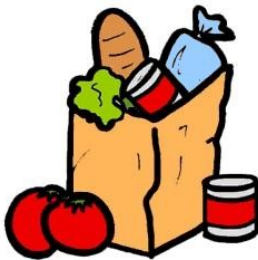
# SUMMERLAND COMMUNITY SUPPORT

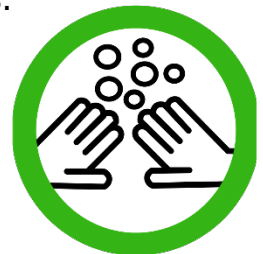
